## TRAINING PROGRAM SCHEDULE

K & M Aviation glider operations will normally be conducted at Jean, NV on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Glider flying will usually be available on Mondays that are national/state holidays; other than normally scheduled days by prearrangement with K & M when we can depend on at least 3-4 tows for the tug.

-SUMMER MONTHS: As days get warmer, 9:00 AM to noon. (Simulated rope breaks,

boxing the wash, etc.) After noon - no training on tow. Remain position behind the tug as much as possible, release at desired

altitude.

-WINTER MONTHS: Training on tow will be conducted as desired/necessary anytime

during an operational day.
